

Romanian Government Proposes Highway Building National Pact

Romanian Government intends to propose a national pact for highway building which will include a commitment to allot at least one per cent of the gross domestic product and infrastructure projects due to be completed by 2020, Mediafax informs.

The Cabinet also promises to develop and modernize railroad, airport and maritime infrastructure, improve transport on the Danube River, as well as modernize 80 per cent of the Romanian national roads by 2012.

Legislation regarding conditions of participation in auctions and the selection of the constructor to make transport infrastructure repairs will be changed, according to the governing program. The reconstruction of the Bucharest's North Station by transforming adjacent areas in commercial centers, financing the construction of the Transylvania Highway's Targu Mures-Bors route, finishing the Bucharest-Comarnic-Brasov highway and building a bridge in Agigea over the Danube-Black Sea Canal are some of the measures included in the governing program.
